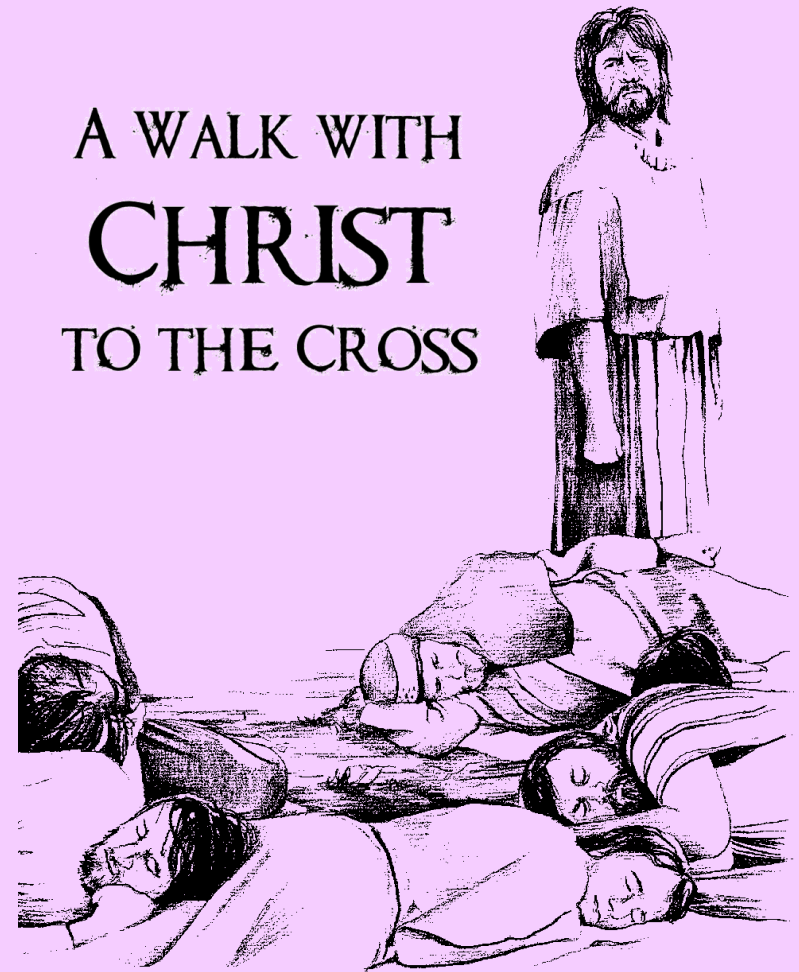


Three Lessons from this Scene
